1.	Why is the conference Virtual?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Due to changing health regulations, PNAAs has chosen to hold our conference virtual this year, allowing for greater participant flexibility.
2.	What is the PNAAs Virtual Platform?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Virtual Platform is an online portal where attendees can experience speaker presentations, gain access to sponsors, visit with exhibitors, meet other attendees virtually, enter dedicated spaces to further networking, participate in social media posts, play along with interactive games, attend invite only gatherings and more. The virtual platform will allow attendees to be connected during the course of the 3-day conference and receive a similar rich experience to attending in-person.

How will attending virtually differ from attending in-person?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For our 20th anniversary conference, PNAAs has partnered with software providers to create the most lifelike immersive virtual conference experience. It will look and feel almost like you're at the conference with virtual environments featuring people avatars, live chat, two-way video conference and a variety of networking lounges and rooms to network with other attendees. You will be able to experience live-streaming presentations from the main presenter stage and SME technical track stage.

What are the benefits to sponsoring?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visibility! • Gain increased efficiency in making networking connections • Build credibility: third party credibility building is more powerful than just walking the floor and having an exhibit. It's like having that same level of trustworthiness as a warm lead/referral. • Set yourself apart from the competition: Show that you are contributing to the industry through your participation as a sponsor. • Show that you are willing to go the extra mile: speaks to what your business sees as important • Avoid getting lost in the crowd of attendees
